Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. Sor Yor. 12/2548

Re: Application for Approval of Form and Terms of Derivatives Contracts Traded on Derivatives Exchange

Whereas the *Derivatives Act B.E. 2546 (2003)* prescribes that the form and terms of derivatives contracts to be traded on the derivatives exchange shall be approved in material substance by the SEC Office; therefore, by virtue of Section 14 and Section 67 of the *Derivatives Act B.E. 2546 (2003)*, the SEC Office hereby issues the following regulations:

Clause 1 Any licensee of derivatives exchange business who wishes to arrange for the trading of any derivatives contract shall submit to the SEC Office an application for approval of the forms and terms of such derivatives contract via Form 67-1 together with the evidentiary documentation supplementing the application, as attached herein.

Clause 2 This Notification shall come into force on 1 June 2005.
