By virtue of Section 19(3) of the Securities and Exchange Act B.E. 2535 (1992) as amended by the Securities and Exchange Act (No. 4) B.E. 2551 (2008) which contains certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of persons, which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 33, Section 34, Section 41, Section 43, Section 44 and Section 64 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of law, the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission hereby issues the following regulations:

Clause 1. The provision in Clause 13 of the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. SorBor. 28/2547 Re: Determination of Fees for Filing, Registration and Other Applications dated 7 July 2004 as amended by the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. SorBor. 40/2549 Re: Determination of Fees for Filing, Registration and Other Applications (No. 5) dated 19 December 2006 shall be repealed and replaced by the following provision:

"Clause 13. The fees for filing applications under the notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission governing approval for investor contacts and standards of conduct shall be at the following rates:

(1) The application for approval Baht 2,000 per application;

(2) The application for renewal of approval Baht 1,000 per application;

(3) The application for certification of approval Baht 200 per copy."

Clause 2. This Notification shall come into force as from 26 December 2008.
