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**Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission
No. SorBor. 3/2552
Re: Determination of Fees for Filing of Registration Statement, Registration
and Other Applications
(No. 18)**

By virtue of Section 19(3) of the Securities and Exchange Act B.E. 2535 (1992) as amended by the Securities and Exchange Act (No. 4) B.E. 2551 (2008) which contains certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of persons, which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 33, Section 34, Section 41, Section 43, Section 44 and Section 64 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of law, the SEC Office hereby issues the following regulations:

Clause 1. Provision in Clause 25/1 of the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. SorBor. 28/2547 Re: Determination of Fees for Filing of Registration Statement, Registration and Other Applications dated 7 July 2004 as amended by the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. SorBor. 29/2550 Re: Determination of Fees for Filing of Registration Statement, Registration and Other Applications (No. 10) dated 17 October 2007 shall be repealed and replaced with the following provision:

“Clause 25/1 Fee for the following applications for approval shall be Baht 15,000 per application providing that the first installment of Baht 5,000 shall be made to the SEC Office on the date of filing of application and the residual payment of Baht 10,000 shall be paid within ten days as from the date the SEC Office notifies the result of preliminary consideration that applicant possesses qualification and does not possess prohibited characteristics:

(1) application for approval of personnel whose name is listed in the registration for personnel who possesses qualification to perform the duty of fund manager under the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission concerning rules, conditions and procedures for appointing and performing of duty of fund manager;

(2) application for approval of personnel whose name is listed in the registration for personnel who possesses qualification to perform the duty of property

fund manager under the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission concerning rules, conditions and procedures for appointing and performing of duty of property fund manager.

Fee for application for maintaining status in the registration under the first paragraph shall be Baht 10,000 per application.”

Clause 2. This Notification shall come into force as from 16 February 2009.
