**Notification of the Securities and Exchange Commission
No. KorKhor. 2/2553
Re: Rules on Application for and Granting of Approval
to Undertake Trust Business
(No. 2)**

By virtue of Section 8 and Section 55 of the Trust for Transactions in Capital Market Act B.E. 2550 (2007) which contain certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of persons, which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 32, Section 33, Section 41 and Section 43 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of law, the Securities and Exchange Commission hereby issues the following regulations:

Clause 1 The provision under Clause 8 of the Notification of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. KorKhor. 9/2552 Re: Rules on Application for and Granting of Approval to Undertake Trust Business dated 4 June 2009 shall be repealed and replaced by the following provision:

“Clause 8 The fee for application for approval to undertake trust business shall be 30,000 Baht per application and shall be paid on the date of application submission.

Fees in respect of the business undertaking shall be in accordance with the notification of the Securities and Exchange Commission governing the relevant matters.

Clause 2 This Notification shall come into force as from 1 March 2010.

Remark: The reason for promulgation of this Notification is to amend the provision related to the fees for undertaking of trust business to ensure appropriateness and to promote the undertaking of the business.
