By virtue of Section 19(3) of the Securities and Exchange Act B.E. 2535 (1992) as amended by the Securities and Exchange Act (No. 4) B.E. 2551 (2008) which contains certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of persons, which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 33, Section 34, Section 41, Section 43, Section 44 and Section 64 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of law, the SEC Office hereby issues the following regulations:

Clause 1 The following provision shall be added as Clause 26/1 of the Notification of the Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission No. SorBor. 28/2547 Re: Determination of Fees for Filing of Registration Statement, Registration and Filing of Other Applications dated 7 July 2004:

“**Clause 26/1** An application for the information by recording onto CD is Baht 50 per CD.”

Clause 2 This Notification shall come into force as from 16 May 2011.
